



The 43rd Windsurfer Class Australian Championships rocked Brighton & Seaclyff Yacht Club, South Australia from January 23 - 26 January, 2020.

Some challenging conditions early saw one day lost, but we sure made up for lost time with a full program of course racing, slalom, marathon and freestyle completed.

A record 116 entries were received and some fantastic times on and off the water were had.

Great mix of competitors – 12 to 72 years old with nineteen competitors under 18 years

In addition to Open racing, the Cruiser division featured over 21 newcomers and returning racers on a shortened course.

The colour and spectacle was amazing from the shore with Australia's best competing in by far the biggest windsurfing Class in Australia.

The racing was close and tight but there were a few standouts. Both the men's and women's overall champions really dominated the racetrack.
